The Board further recommended that the above mentioned Certificate Courses of the SLIET may be recognised as equivalent to the 10+2 qualification and the Diploma Courses as equivalent to the Diploma awarded by the various State Boards of Technical Education in the appropriate fields for the purpose of recruitment to the posts and services under the Central Government.

No. 5-1/94-PLI.—The President is pleased to extend the coverage of Postal Life Insurance to the Rural Public in India under the "Rural Postal Life Insurance Scheme-1995 (Gramscen Dak Jeevan Beema Yojna-1995)".

1. SHORT TITLE :

The scheme shall be entitled "Rural Postal Life Insurance Scheme-1995".

2. COMMENCEMENT :

"Rural Postal Life Insurance Scheme-1995" here-in-after referred to as the 'Rural Scheme' as notified will come into force w.e.f. 24-3-95 for a period of three years initially. The further continuance of the Scheme is subject to the specific approval of the Central Government after reviewing the experience and performance of the Scheme".

3. OBJECTIVE :

The scheme is envisaged to provide insurance cover to the rural public in general and benefit weaker sections and women workers of rural areas in particular.

4. APPLICABILITY OF POST OFFICE INSURANCE FUND RULES :

POIF Rules as amended from time to time, shall be applicable to the "Rural Scheme" Mutatis-mutandis except where special provisions have been made and notified under this scheme. Such special provisions shall be applicable to the exclusion and in supersession of corresponding POIF Rules. In case of any doubt arising in interpretation or applicability of any rule under the Rural Scheme, the matter shall be referred to DG Posts whose decision shall be final.

5. ELIGIBILITY :

The scheme shall cover all persons, male or female, who permanently reside in rural areas and are ordinarily residents in India to the exclusion of Foreigners and Non-resident Indians provided they have attained majority.

5.1. However, where a policy-holder who is a resident of India subsequently shifts his residence outside India, temporarily or permanently, he/she shall make arrangements to make payments of due premia within India in the specified Post Office in Indian currency.

5.2. All claims settled in respect of such persons who may have shifted their residence outside India shall be paid within India only in Indian currency in accordance with POIF Rules.

6. AGE LIMIT :

A person who is not less than 19 years and not more than 45 years (40 years in case of AIA policies) on his/her next birth day shall be eligible for this scheme.

6.1. The proponent shall be required to furnish proof of age alongwith the proposal form and in the manner prescribed by the Department.

7. LIMITS OF INSURANCE :

The minimum limit for insurance under this scheme shall be Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand). The maximum limit under the medical scheme, taking total sum assured under all plans shall not exceed Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) while the maximum limit in respect of Non-medical scheme, taking total sum assured under all plans shall not exceed Rs. 25,000. - (Rupees twenty five thousand).

8. MEDICAL EXAMINATION :

Rules regarding Medical Examination as applicable to PLI scheme also apply mutatis-mutandis to the 'Rural Scheme' Two types of policies i.e. with and without medical exami-
