No. 5-1/94-PLI.—The President is pleased to extend the coverage of Postal Life Insurance to the Rural Public in India under the "Rural Postal Life Insurance Scheme-1995 (Grameen Dak Jeevan Beema Yojna-1995").

I. SHORT TITLE :

The soheme shall be entitled "Rural Postal Life Insurance Scheme-1995".

2. CUMMENCEMENT :

"Rural Postal Life Insurance Scheme-1995" here-in-after referred to as the 'Rural Scheme' as notified will come into force w.e.f. 24-3-95 for a period of three years initially. The further containance of the Scheme is subject to the specific approval of the Central Covernment after reviewing the experience and performance of the Scheme".

3. OBJECTIVE :

The scheme is envisaged to provide insurance cover to the rural public in general and benefit weaker sections and women workers of rural areas in particular.

4. APPLICABILITY OF POST OFFICE INSURANCE FUND RULES:

PCIF Rules as amended from time to time, shall be applicable to the "Rural Scheme' Mutalis-mutandin except where special provisions have been made and notified under this scheme. Such special provisions shall be applicable to the exclusion and in supersession of corresponding POIF Rules. In case of any doubt arising in interpretation or applicability of any rule under the Rural Schome, the matter shall be referred to DG Posta whose decision shall be final.

5. ELIGIBILITY:

The scheme shall cover all personse, male or female, who permanently reside in rural areas and are ordinarily residents in India to the exclusion of Foreigners and Non-resident Indians por ided they have attained majority.

- 5.1. However, where a policy-holder who is a resident of India subsequently shifts his residence outside India, temporarily or permanently, he/she shall make arrangements to make payments of due premia with-in India in the specified Post Office in Indian cur-rency.
- 5.2. All claims settled in respect of such persons who may have shifted their residence outside dudia shall be paid within India only in Indian currency in accor-dance with POIF Rules.

6. AGE LIMIT :

A person who is not less than 19 years and not more than 45 years (40 years in case of AEA policies) on his her next birth day shall be eligible for this scheme.

6.1. The proponent shall be recquired to furnish proof of age alongwith the proposal form and in the man-ner prescribed by the Department.

7. LIMITS OF INSURANCE :

The minimum limit for insurance under this scheme shall be Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand). The maximum limit under the medical scheme, taking total sum assured under all plans shall not exceed Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh) while the maximum limit in respect of Non-medical scheme, taking total sum assured under all plans shall not exceed Rs. 25,000 - (Rupees (wenty five (housand)).

8. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

Rules regarding Medical Examination as applicable to PLI scheme also apply mutatio-mutantis to the Rural Scheme Two types of policies i.e. with and without medical exami-
