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During the past, some of the pass-out students have submitted that the respective Boards of Education have made corrections in their names or in the names of their parents and have put different dates on such certificates, i.e. one at the time of issuance and the other one while doing correction thereof.

The position was also checked up from NIT, Kurukshetra, which confirmed that they are also doing such corrections after charging some prescribed fee.

The proposal regarding such change (s) as submitted by academic section and recommended by Dean (Academics) has already been approved by Director, SLIET, on dated 08.09.2020, subject to ratification by the Senate.

As approved, correction in name of the students / parents, as the case may be, shall be made as follows :-

- 1. No fee for correction, if the correction is brought to the notice of the academic section within a period of one year of issuance of DMC. However, a fee of Rs.500/- (as already approved by Senate per DMC) and Rs.1,000/- for final Certificate/Diploma/Degree (as already approved by Senate) shall be charged if correction is brought to the notice of the academic section after one year of issuance of the document.
- A fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) shall be charged from the pass out students, if the correction in name is required to be done on the basis of such changes made by the concerned Board of Examination for the 10<sup>th</sup> class certificate.
- 10<sup>th</sup> Class certificate issued by the concerned Board of Examination shall be used as a reference document for correction in name of the students or name of his / her parents.

TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE RULES FOR EVALUATION OF FRACTIONAL CREDIT **Item** COURSES / EXTRA ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES IN THE STUDY SCHEME OF UG PROGRAMS 30.9.1 With reference to Item No. 29.2 of the 29th meting of the Senate held on 17.07.2020, there are three fractional credit courses / extra academic activities in the UG study scheme. The subject codes for fractional credit courses / extra academic activities are EAAA (Sports activities), EAAB (Literary / Cultural / Hobby activities) and EAAC (Social/NCC/NSS activities). The rules for evaluation criterion for these activities are proposed as under :-1. The students have to register for any one activity (EAAA/EAAB/EAAC) at the time of registration for a particular semester as per the study scheme. 2. The students shall complete all the three activities in their complete UG program. 3. Dean (Acad) will notify the overall coordinator for each activity and sub-committees under each activity. 4. The overall coordinator will assign the students to a sub-committee of an activity as per the choice of the students. 5. The sub-committee will facilitate the conduct/training and evaluate the students for the chosen activity at the end of the particular semester. 6. The evaluation of the activity will be as per the evaluation criteria of a Lab course. However, the basis of evaluation will be S/US grade. The matter is placed before the Senate for approval, please. Decision Approved. Further, the overall coordinator of each activity shall compile and submit the results. TO FORMULATE THE GUIDELINES FOR SLIET QUALITY PUBLICATION Item 30.9.2 AWARDS TO THE Ph. D. / PG STUDENTS The Institute has established "SLIET Quality Publication Awards" (SQPA) to Ph. D. / PG students, in view of the decision taken by the Finance Committee in its 52nd meeting. Many a times, few applications are received which require intervention of the competent authority. To smoothen the process, following additions to the existing guidelines are proposed :-1. On the date of application, the students have not completed final viva voce of the thesis; 2. The authors for the paper are only supervisor (s) and the regular students of SLIET and the paper is related to the work of the thesis; 3. The decision of Director, SLIET, shall be final and binding on all. The matter is placed before the Senate for approval, please. Decision The following rules are approved :-1. On the date of application, the students have not completed final viva voce of the thesis; 2. The authors for the paper are only supervisor (s) and the regular students of SLIET and the paper is related to the work of the thesis;

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3. The claimant of the award shall be the first author of the paper and having affiliation with SLIET, Longowal; 4. The decision of Director, SLIET, shall be final and binding on all. Further, Chairman, Senate, desired that the policy be used in letter and spirit of award, to promote R/S culture.
