ON 28.04.2021 IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM, ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK**

The 31st meeting of the Senate of SLIET is held on 28.04.2021, at 11.30 a.m., in the Committee Room of the Institute. The meeting is held online.

	<p>A student, namely, Alok Kumar (Registration Number – CDE/2010272) was admitted during the academic year 2020-21 and allotted the branch as Certificate in Data Entry and Word Processing. He was admitted under the category of OBC-NCL and was accordingly required to submit the certificate in this regard in the SET office by the stipulated date. However, the said student has failed to submit the said certificate and requested for change of branch. Chairman, SET-2020, has proposed that the branch of the above student may be changed from CDE to CFF, where 01 seat is lying vacant.</p> <p>It is brought out herein that, the student under reference has already cleared his first semester with SGPA of 8.60 on a ten-point scale having studied all the courses of Certificate in Data Entry & Word Processing. It is not out of place to mention herein that the credits for both the programs are same i.e. 25 credits, however, there is a mis-match of only two courses.</p> <p>In view of the above position, the matter is placed before the Senate, for consideration and decision in the matter, please.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Decision</u></p> <p><i>The Senate approved the proposal of Chairman, SET-2020, to change the branch of Alok Kumar, from CDE to CFF, since 01 seat in this trade is lying vacant. It may be ensured by Chairman, SET-2020, that no other student is available in higher merit than this student. This student shall now be treated under “general category”.</i></p>

	<p>A student, namely, Nand Kishor (Registration Number – GFT/2040062) vide his application dated 12.01.2021, requested to withdrawal of his studentship from the Institute. 	<p>A student, Vinay Kumar Molathoti (Registration Number GME/1740881) belongs to UG 2017 batch. Due to non fulfilment of eligibility criterion, he was placed as a 2018 batch UG student (year back) vide notice No. SLIET/AS/4755 dated 19.11.2019. At this very moment, the student is studying in 6th semester.</p>

	<p>The study scheme of UG – 2016 programs was applicable to this student initially. The study scheme of the Institute was revised for all the UG programs from the year 2018. Therefore, due to his year-back (2018 batch), the study scheme of 2018 was also made applicable to him. The subjects of 2016 batch study scheme and 2018 batch study scheme could not be matched / mapped fully for him. At that moment, the student had studied four semesters under 2016 batch UG study scheme.</p> <p>The academic section was asked to put up a comprehensive proposal in this regard. It was decided that DMCs of 1st to 4th semesters shall be issued as per the 2016 batch UG study scheme and the remaining DMCs of 5th to 8th semester shall be issued as per the 2018 batch UG study scheme. The total credit requirement to complete the UG program shall be 190 credits.</p> <p>The matter was put to Director, for approval, who accorded the same on dated 03.04.2021.</p> <p>The matter is placed before the Senate for ratification, please.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Decision</u></p> <p><i>Ratified</i></p>
<p>tem 31.8</p>	<p>TO CONSIDER LETTER FROM AICTE REGARDING EMPHASIS ON PROVIDING HIGHER EDUCATION INCLUDING TECHNICAL EDUCATION IN REGIONAL LANGUAGES IN THE NEP-2020</p>
	<p>An email dated 04.03.2021 has been received from AICTE, New Delhi. With this email a letter dated 03.03.2021, written by the Chairman, AICTE, has been enclosed. The gist of this letter is re-produced below :-</p> <p><i>“In the light of NEP, the Executive Committee of the AICTE, has decided to start Technical Education in the regional languages. Only such institutions having NBA accreditation in the engineering programs, shall be allowed to start regional language division in the same discipline. The Institutes can add regional language division in the program in which the NBA program accreditation exists as per their choice.</i></p> <p><i>All Universities are requested to make such provision in their statute through Senate/BOS/BOG to start the higher education including technical education in regional languages. Initially, the Institutes providing quality education i.e. having NBA accreditation / NAAC accreditation / NIRF ranking, can be considered for starting courses on regional languages for which over and above the approved intake can be given”.</i></p> <p>In view of the above position, the matter is placed before the Senate, for discussion and decision, please.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Decision</u></p> <p><i>The matter was deliberated upon in detail. It is decided that focused efforts be made by the Institute, starting from the ICD programs. HODs shall encourage the faculty of their respective departments to develop the course contents in regional language, i.e. Hindi and Punjabi.</i></p>

<p>Item 31.9</p>	<p>TO APPROVE PROPOSAL OF CHAIRMAN SET-2021 REGARDING ADMISSION 2021-22 (MERIT BASED FOR ICD AND CBT FOR SET-III, SET-V, SET-VI AND SET-VII)</p>
	<p>The Core Committee of SET-2021, has put up a proposal on dated 15.04.2021, stating that the cases of Covid-19 are again increasing day-by-day as per the Government sources. In this regard, the CBSE, have also declared vide its notification on 14th April, 2021, for cancellation of the Board Examinations of Class-X which, otherwise, were to be held from 4th May, 2021 to 7th June, 2021. A copy of the said notification of the CBSE, has been attached with the proposal, submitted by Chairman, SET-2021.</p> <p>In view of the present situation, the Core Committee of SET-2021, has proposed that admission to ICD programs during the session 2021-22, shall be made on merit basis as per THE CRITERIA FOLLOWED IN THE YEAR 2020-21.</p> <p>Further, the Core Committee has also proposed that admission to B. E. Lateral Entry (SET-III), M. Sc. (SET-VI), M. Tech (SET-VII) and Ph. D. (SET-V) shall be made through Computer Based Test (CBT) for the session 2021-22. The schedules for admission to all the programs, as mentioned above, has also been attached with the proposal.</p> <p>The admission schedule has been approved by Director, SLIET, on dated 16.04.2021, subject to ratification by the Senate. A copy of the approved schedule has already been forwarded to Chairman, SET-21, for advertisement and for taking further necessary action in the matter.</p> <p>In view of the above, the matter is placed before the Senate, for approval of admission criteria and ratification of admission schedule, please. All the documents in this regard are placed at <u>Annexure "E" (page 24 to 27).</u></p> <hr/> <p><u>Decision</u></p> <p><i>The proposal is approved by the Senate. Further, the Senate authorized the Standing Committee to take the decision, on change in admission schedule, if required, in view pandemic situation.</i></p>
<p>Item 31.10</p>	<p>TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL FOR CONDUCT OF REPEAT FOR BACKLOG SUBJECTS OF ODD SEMESTER ON SELF STUDY MODE</p>
	<p>(a) A number of requests from the students regarding giving them a chance to repeat the backlog subjects of odd semester. In view of the Covid-19 situation, the Institute could not extend the provision of repeat for of subjects, in the odd semester of 2020-21.</p> <p>It is proposed that the final year students of all the programs (ICD, UG and PG) and all the eligible students of pass out batches may be allowed to appear for the repeat of backlog subjects (including lab courses) of odd semester on self study mode. The process shall be completed by the mid of June, 2021.</p> <p>(b) During the end semester exams of odd semester 2020-21 (through online mode), some of the students have opted for pen/paper mode of examination, who faced technical problems or were not satisfied with online examinations, in view of the letter No. SLIET/Dean (A) / 2020 / 830 dated 05.10.2020.</p> <p>It is proposed to give one more chance to such students to appear in the end semester exam through online mode, during the month of May/June, 2021.</p> <p>(c) A number of requests have also been received from the students of pass out batches, regarding improvement in the CGPA.</p> <p>It is proposed to conduct the improvement examination for such students during the month of May/June, 2021.</p> <p>The matter is placed before the Senate, for consideration and approval, please.</p> <hr/>

	<p><u>Decision</u></p> <p><i>The proposals at (a), (b) & (c) as above, are approved by the Senate. It was decided to conduct the exams through "online mode", if required. Further action shall be taken by the academic section / HODs concerned.</i></p>
Item 31.11	<p><i>TO CONSIDER REQUEST OF ASHUTOSH KUMAR, GEC/1940422 TO RE-APPEAR IN THE EXAMINATION OF 3RD SEMESTER</i></p>
	<p>Mr. Ashutosh Kumar (Registration number – GEC/1940442) a second year UG student in the branch of Electronics & Communication Engineering, has requested to appear in the third phase online classes / exams. At the same time, he could not submit his online quizzes, assignments, minors and was also absent in the major examinations. The reason stated for the same by the student is that he father was severely ill and undergoing cancer treatment at the AIIMS, New Delhi, for the past two months.</p> <p>It is pertinent to mention here that all the examinations of the odd semester 2020-21 for these students have already been conducted.</p> <p>The DAAC of ECE department, held its meeting on 02.03.2021, and recommended his case for consideration. Item 31.12	<p><i>TO NOTE REPORT ON VISIT BY NBA EXPERT TEAM FOR ACCREDITATION OF 07 UG PROGRAMS OF THE INSTITUTE</i></p>
	<p>The Institute had, during the year 2019, filed SARs of 07 UG programs for their accreditation by the NBA, New Delhi. The visit schedules were also proposed in the year 2020 (between March, 2020 to August, 2020). However, due to Covid-19 pandemic, the NBA expert team could not visit the Institute during last year.</p> <p>The visit dates were proposed afresh to the NBA, New Delhi, this year (between April, 2021 to June, 2021). The NBA agreed to undertake the visit to the Institute from 9th to 11th April, 2021.</p> <p>Three local external experts, i.e. from the nearby Institutions in Chandigarh / Punjab, visited the Institute physically and seven external experts (01 for each UG program) besides Chairman of the entire team were available through online mode.</p> <p>The required data was made available to the team during their visit to the Institute and the requisite report / certificate has also been sent to the NBA, New Delhi, through email, a few days back. During the Exit Meeting, held on 11.04.2021, the Institute has opted to continue with the NBA approval for all the seven UG programs.</p> <p>The final outcome in the matter from the NBA, New Delhi, is awaited.</p> <p>The matter is placed before the Senate, for information, please.</p> <hr/>

	<p>A pass-out student, Mr. Prithwiraj Majee, Registration Number – DCT/1610125, vide his email dated 23.03.2021, addressed to Director, SLIET, has stated that ;</p> <p><u>Quote</u></p> <p><i>"He has completed three-year program in the discipline of Chemical Technology from SLIET in the year 2019. He was about to get appointment at Indian Oil Corporation Limited, as Junior Engineer, but, on subsequent document verification, his candidature has been rejected stating that he has passed Diploma in Chemical Technology, as offered by SLIET. He has requested for reconsideration of his Diploma in Chemical Engineering, because no company in all over India is accepting Diploma in Chemical Technology. He has stated that the course contents in both the cases are the same. He has requested to look into this matter as his job prospects are at stake".</i></p> <p><u>Unquote</u></p> <p>The above email was forwarded to the academic section as well as HOD (Chemical Engineering). Vide email dated 26.04.2021, HOD (Chemical Engg) has suggested that the matter may please be deliberated upon in the 31st meeting of the Senate, to be held on 28.04.2021.</p> <p>In view of the above, the matter is placed before the Senate, for consideration and decision, please.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Decision</u></p> <p><i>The Senate has decided that the matter be referred back to BOS of the Chemical Engineering Department, for discussion and recommendations. The final report in this regard as received from HOD (Chemical Engg) shall be placed before the next meeting of the Standing Committee of the Senate, for discussion and decision.</i></p> <p><i>It was further decided that HOD (Chemical Engg) shall provide to the student all the documents in support of his claim, to be submitted to IOCL. Rs.500/- for first copy and Rs.100/- for subsequent copy 2. Postal charges (within India) : Rs.100/- 3. Postal charges (outside India) : Rs.1,000/-

	<p>The above charges were approved in the 3rd meeting of the Senate, held on 11.04.2009. It may please be noted that these charges are applicable since the year 2009, i.e. for the last more than twelve years. With the passage of time, it is felt that the amount of Rs.500/- plus Rs.100/- is quite meagre and needed to be revised suitably.</p> <p>It is proposed that the charges for preparation of transcript documents may please be revised to Rs.1,000/- for first copy and Rs.200/- for subsequent copy.</p> <p>Further, due to the situation arising out of Covid-19 pandemic, the process of sending the documents through postal services, was stopped from March, 2020, onwards. All the documents are being sent through email as well as by post. It is proposed that the words "postal charges" may be changed to "processing charges". 	<p>The Institute admits students to M. Tech programs through CCMT and to M. Sc. programs through CCMN. For admission during this year, i.e. 2021-22, the nominated authority is MNIT, Jaipur.</p> <p>Chairman, SET-2021, vide his letter No. SLIET/SET-2021/1855 dated 26.04.2021, has informed that two emails dated 16.04.2021 and 22.04.2021, were received from CCMT/CCMN, MNIT, Jaipur. Through these emails, they requested the Institute to go through last year's qualifying degree and GATE examination paper mapping (i.e. mapping matrix). If the Institute feels that there are some qualifying degrees which were previously not present in this mapping matrix, but their addition might increase the pool of candidates eligible for admission to that particular branch, necessary action to include the same may be taken by SLIET, accordingly.</p> <p>Chairman, SET-2021, took up the matter with all HODs of teaching departments in the Institute. After getting input from HODs, he has drawn up the special eligibility criteria. In view of the above, the matter is placed before the Senate, for consideration & approval, please.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Decision</u></p> <p><i>This issue was discussed by the Senate, in detail. It was decided that the matter shall be referred back to the HODs of all the teaching departments, for discussion in their respective BOS. The reports as received from HODs, shall be placed in the Senate, for final decision. However, the admission criteria for CCMT-2021 & CCMN-2021, shall remain un-changed.</i></p>
