

Frequently Asked Questions

(Regarding opening of the Institute in Physical Mode
for final year students w.e.f. 6th September, 2021)

Question-1	Is it mandatory to report?
Answer	No. It is purely optional as per willingness of the student and consent of his/ her parents.
Question-2	Do we need consent of our parents?
Answer	Yes, consent of parents is required in the prescribed undertaking form, which is available on institute website. The link of same is http://sliet.ac.in/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/Schedule-for-reporting-in-Hostel-UG-Final-year-JEE-2018-and-LEET-2019-batch_0001-Copy.pdf
Question-3	To report the Institute, what is the condition about vaccination?
Answer	The student must have got first dose of vaccination and he/ she has to bring a Negative RT-PCR report, of within 72 hours at the time of reporting in hostel.
Question-4	Will it be possible to maintain social distancing in the Institute and Hostel premises?
Answer	You are adult, grown up and mature. Hence, students are expected to maintain the social distancing and to behave responsible as per well-defined Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).
Question-5	What about Health Centre facilities at SLIET?
Answer	SLIET Health Centre is having only primary Health care facilities. For all other requirements, the Institute is dependent on District Level Health Facilities available at Longowal and Sangrur. For Emergency Cases, ambulance is available to deal with.
Question-6	What about availability of Medical Officer in the Institute Health Centre?
Answer	SLIET Health Centre is having two Medical Officers, one male Medical Officer (regular) and one female Medical Officer (contractual) and necessary supporting staff. However, there may have situations, when Medical Officer(s) may be on leave.
Question-7	What about my second dose of vaccination, which is due in next few days?
Answer	The Institute has arranged vaccination camps at SLIET campus with the support of District administration. However, for all such matters, Institute depends on District Administration.
Question-8	What about my attendance, if I am not willing to report physically?
Answer	There is no emphasis on attendance compulsion for students who are not willing to join physically. Such students may continue their studies in ONLINE mode. However, all the students are advised to be regular in their classes (offline/online).
Question-9	What about outside campus movement?
Answer	All movements within the campus are allowed only for academic activities. The students are not allowed to go outside the campus without prior permission from HOD concerned/ Dean (SW). They are expected to stay within the safe area of Bio-bubble.
Question-10	How long we have been allowed to stay in the campus?
Answer	Students are expected to stay till end of odd Semester/ Examinations, as per Academic Calendar. In case any COVID-19 related guidelines received from State Govt./ Centre Govt., the students may be asked to vacate the hostels.
Question-11	What will be the mode of conduction of examination?
Answer	It will be communicated in due course of time.
Question-12	What will happen if any student in campus gets infected with COVID-19?
Answer	The institute has created an isolation centre for students, who gets infected with COVID-19 and the treatment would be as per govt. guidelines. However, if required, the student may be shifted to Civil Hospital, Sangrur as per the instructions of medical authorities and parents will be informed accordingly.
