	The minutes of the 2 nd meeting of the Result Moderation Board (RMB) held on 09.01.2018, were placed before the Senate in its 20 th meeting, vide Item No. 20.29.1 held on 15.01.2018.
	A particular reference was made to ICD (2014), UG (2016) and PG (2016) Rules and Regulations and its sub-section (D-19), UG (24) and PG (27) which relates to "Powers to modify the Rules and Regulations". Accordingly some modifications to ICD, UG and PG Rules & Regulations were recommended by the RMB in its 2 nd meeting held on 09.01.2018. One of the recommendations of the RMB is re-produced as under:-
	"After expiry of the normal duration of any program (ICD/UG/PG), if a student repeats a course, he/she shall have to re-register with the HOD concerned after paying full semester fees and other fees, as applicable".
	The minutes of the 2 nd meeting of the RMB held on 09.01.2018, were approved by the Senate in its 20 th meeting held on 15.01.2018. However, the academic section had been facing some difficulties in implementing the above decision. Accordingly, a fresh proposal in this regard was put up to Director, SLIET, which has been approved on 04.08.2021. The same is re-produced as
	under:-

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"After the expiry of the normal duration of any program (ICD/UG/PG) if a student is required to repeat course (s) when the particular course (s) is / are offered, he / she has to register for a semester (odd/even) with concerned HOD after payment of full semester fee as applicable at that time irrespective of number of course (s) applied for repeat of any semester".

The matter is placed before the Senate, for ratification, please.

Item CLARIFICATION ON DECISION TAKEN VIDE ITEM NO. 30.5 OF 30TH MEETING OF THE SENATE HELD ON 29.12.2020, REGARDING CHARGING OF FEES FOR NAME CORRECTION

The proposal submitted by the Academic Section to charge fees from the pass-out students to change their names or the names of their father/mother, was approved by the Senate vide Item No. 30.5 in its 30th meeting held on 29.12.2020. However, the academic section is facing certain difficulties in implementing the proposal and has sought clarification on the above decision. Accordingly, the academic section has submitted the following proposal / revision, for more clarity on the decision taken by the Senate vide Item No. 30.5, in its 30th meeting held on 29.12.2020:-

Passed by Senate No fee for correction, if the correction is brought to the notice of the academic section within a period of one year of issuance of DMC. However, a fee of Rs.500/-(as already approved by the Senate per DMC) and Rs.1000/for final certificate / diploma / charged degree shall be correction is brought to the notice of the academic section after one year of issuance of document.

Proposed revision needed

No fee for correction, if the correction is brought to the notice of the academic section within a period of one year of issuance of DMC or Certificate / Diploma/Degree/any other Certificate. However, the following fee will be charged if correction is brought to the notice of the academic section after one year of issuance of document:-

 A fee of Rs.5000/- shall be charged from the pass-out students, if correction in name is required to be done on the basis of such changes made by the concerned Board of Examination for the 10th class certificate. Change of name on DMCs / Degree / Diploma / Certificate / Any other Certificate will be done on the basis of the change of name done on the 10th Class / Secondary School / Matriculation Certificate by the concerned Board of Examination.

A fee of Rs.5000/- will be charged from on-roll / ex-students irrespective of number of programs and additional fee as prescribed at Point No.1 for change of name on documents like DMCs / Certificate / Diploma / Degree / any other certificate etc. will also be charged.

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3. 10th class certificate issued by the concerned Board of Examination shall be used as a reference document for correction in name of the students or name of his / her parents.

10th Class / Secondary School / Matriculation Certificate issued by the concerned Board of Examination shall be used as a reference document for correction in name of the student or name of his / her parents.

REGISTRATION TO THE ODD SEMESTER OF THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2021-22

As per the academic rules, there are certain conditions for promotion from first year to second year, from second year to third year and so on. During the academic session 2020-21, no such conditions were imposed and all the students were allowed promotion to the next year of the program due to Covid-19 pandemic. Now, the registration for the odd semester of the academic session 2021-22 is in progress. In order to finalize the registration process, the academic section has sought instructions/ clarification regarding eligibility conditions. The following proposal was submitted to Director, SLIET:-

"During the session 2020-21, the students have faced almost the same situation of Covid-19 pandemic, which had happened during the session 2019-20. It is, therefore, proposed to approve the same imposed conditions for promotion during the session 2021-22 in the larger interest of the students, subject to ratification by the Senate".

The above proposal has been approved by Director, SLIET, on dated 06.08.2021. The matter is placed before the Senate, for ratification, please.

Item 32.10

PROVISION FOR RESEARCH PROMOTION GRANT FOR THE NEWLY RECRUITED FACULTY MEMBERS AS SEED MONEY

The Institute supported young faculty of the Institute by Research grant upto Rs. 1.00 lac under TEQIP-III. The Senate in its 24th meeting held on 31.05.2019, observed to extend financial support to young faculty for promotion of research upto Rs. 5.00 lacs. (Copy placed at *Annexure-"E"* (Page 25-26).

The Board of Management of the Institute in its 29th meeting held on 28.05.2018, vide Agenda Item No. 29.03 (26.06) decided to follow AICTE regulations being a Technical Institution. The Recruitment Rules for direct recruitment as well as for promotion under Career Advancement Scheme has also been adopted by BoM with necessary modifications on the basis of AICTE Regulations.

In accordance with AICTE Regulations, 2019, Rule 2.10, there is a provision of **Research Promotion Grant**, which is reproduced below:-

"The thrust has to be given for improving quality of search and development in the Universities/Institutions, therefore, all the AICTE recognized Institutions shall create a separate budget and provide financial assistant to their **faculty members** for strengthening research activities".

Therefore, to create opportunity for newly recruited faculty in the year 2020-21 onwards, it is proposed to make provisions for Research Promotion Grant upto Rs. 5.00 lacs each as Seed money. The faculty members who were appointed earlier (preferably Assistant Professor) the provision of Research Promotion Grant will be provided based on their research proposals subject to availability of funds.

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The Research Grant will be sanctioned based on evaluation of the research proposal submitted by the faculty through a committee constituted by Director, SLIET.

The matter is placed before the Senate for consideration and decision, please.

Item 32.11.2 TO APPROVE NORMALIATION OF MARKS FOR APPLICANTS SEEKING ADMISSION TO ICD PROGRAMS AT SLIET, LONGOWAL

A meeting of the Core Committee of SET-2021, was held on 16.08.2021, regarding normalization of marks for applicants seeking admission for ICD students programs. In the said meeting, the Core Committee has conveyed that in view of COVID-19 situation, various Boards have declared their results based on internal assessment without any merit list. In the light of such circumstances, the SET office has opined to normalize the marks for admission to ICD programs based on the results declared by the CBSE Board. The results of State or Central Boards, where the marks of their toppers have already been declared as 100% or more than CBSE topper of 2021, will not be normalized. Further, the SET office has proposed the following formula for admission to ICD programs:-

The matter is placed before the Senate, for consideration and approval, please.

<u>Decision</u>: Proposed normalization formula approved for all the candidates.

Further, the Senate resolved that if there is any ambiguity in preparation of merit list, the Standing Committee of Senate is authorized to take a final decision.

INFORMATION ABOUT OPENING OF THE INSTITUTE IN PHYSICAL MODE FOR FINAL YEAR UG STUDENTS WITH EFFECT FROM SEPTEMBER 06, 2021
