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| ITEM 35.10 | COMPLIANCE OF UGC (GRANT OF DEGREE AND OTHER AWARDS BY THE UNIVERSITIES) REGULATIONS, 2008 |
| | <p>The Secretary, University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi, has written a D. O. letter bearing No. F.2-10/2022 (CPP-II) dated 08.04.2022, to the Vice Chancellors of all the Universities and the Principals of all the Colleges, related to the subject cited above.</p> <p>Vide D. O. letter referred above, it has been conveyed that the Commission has been receiving a large number of grievances from the students enrolled in different programmes of study offered by Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) regarding the delay in awarding the Degrees. Further, the relevant para on the subject is re-produced below:-</p> <p><i>"The Degree award date/s shall be within 180 days of the date/s by which the students are expected to qualify and become eligible for them".</i></p> <p>In a meeting of Deans/HODs held on 14.12.2021, it was discussed and resolved that the Annual Convocation may be scheduled on the Foundation Day of the Institute, i.e. 20th December, every year. Further, in case the Annual Convocation could not be held on the Foundation Day of the Institute, then the condition stipulated by the UGC, as above, be allowed to be ensured.</p> <p>All supporting documents in this regard are placed at <u>Annexure-"J"(page 44 to 49)</u>.</p> <p>The matter is placed before the Senate, for deliberations and decision, please.</p> <p>Resolution</p> <p>The Senate approved the proposal as under:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Annual Convocation of the Institute shall be held on the Foundation Day, i.e. 20th December, every year. | ITEM 35.11 | OFFERING OF MINOR DEGREE BY THE TEACHING DEPARTMENTS OF THE INSTITUTE |
| | <p>Vide letter No. Dean (A) / 2022 / 54 dated 07.04.2022, all heads of teaching departments, were intimated regarding offering of Minor Degree, along with specified format, and other terms & conditions.</p> <p>Subsequently, a meeting was held by Dean (Academics) with all heads of the teaching departments on 12.05.2022. During the meeting, the data / input supplied by the HODs were discussed, in detail. It was decided, as under, unanimously :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minor Degree shall be offered to the UG students from 2021- batch onwards. Minor Degree shall be offered to UG students starting from 4th semester onwards till 8th semester. In each semester, 4 credits (One subject with or without Laboratory subject) of Minor degree courses will be offered upto 8th semester. In the 8th semester, online/MOOCs/SWAYAM courses may be offered. For online/MOOCs/SWAYAM, courses, marks awarded will be considered. To award the grades, Institute's grading pattern will be followed. There shall be requirement of a minimum of 8 students who shall be offered Minor Degree, in each department. However, the maximum/upper limit shall be 120 students plus 10%. If more than 120 number of students opted for minor degree, then, the merit based on 3rd semester marks only shall be considered to select 120 students. Minor Degree will be offered in each semester, and, shall be offered to the UG students from 2021 batch onwards. The proposed Rules & Regulations for the offer of "Minor Degree" are attached at <u>Annexure-"K"(page 50 to 51)</u>. It was also decided that new bucket (s) for Honour's Degree shall be suggested by the heads of teaching departments. 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| ITEM 35.12 | TO CONSIDER CHARGING OF CONTINUATION FEE FROM THE STUDENTS UPON THEIR JOINING BACK IN THE INSTITUTE AFTER TEMPORARY WITHDRAWAL OF SEMESTER (S) |
| | <p>During the recent past, the academic section has received applications from the students of various programmes, i.e. ICD, UG and PG, regarding semester fee waiver, who had withdrawn from the Institute for one or more semesters, with or without permission from the Institute. The relevant portion of the existing rule (s) is re-produced below:-</p> <p><i>"Normally, those students are allowed to re-register who have taken prior permission to drop the semester / temporary withdrawal. Such students have to pay Rs.200/- as re-registration fee in addition to normal semester fee and charges.</i></p> <p><i>In case, a student fails to submit a request to withdraw from a semester, he / she may be allowed to re-register only with the permission of Director. He / she is required to pay all the semester fee and charges of the intervening semesters along with Rs.200/- as re-registration fee and normal semester fee and charges.</i></p> <p><i>In all such cases, the concerned student will be required to submit an affidavit/self-declaration by the parents clearly stating that he / she was not involved / indulged in any unlawful activity during his / her absence or temporary withdrawal from the Institute".</i></p> <p>A committee consisting of Dean (Academics), Dean (Students Welfare), HOD (Chemistry), HOD (ECE), Associate Dean (AP), Associate Dean (Academics) and officiating DR (Acctts) was constituted to deliberate upon the issue and to give its report / recommendations. Two meetings of the above committee were held on 30.03.2022 and 06.04.2022, respectively. The student was regular upto February, 2020 ; The student joined in the Indian Railways on 27.02.2020, without taking permission. <p>It is further brought out ;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The academic section submitted that the student is at fault for not taking the permission (Rule PG6.2, Re-registration, cited as P5.3) for dropping the semester as per PG rules & Regulations. The student has cleared 3 semesters as on December, 2019, as a regular student and got CGPA 8.79. • AR (Academics) has commented that in view of Rule PG6.2, cited as Rule P5.3, the student may not be allowed to re-register. • In view of the decisions taken by the Senate in its 22nd and 23rd meetings, held on 31.10.2018 and 15.01.2019, respectively, the matter was referred to HOD (Mech.Engg.) for discussing the case in the DAAC of their department, under "early joining terms & conditions" as only thesis is pending. |



The decision of Senate taken in its 23rd meeting, Item No. 23.2 (22.11), held on 15.01.2019, is quoted as "the early joining rules are also permissible / applicable to the students placed in reputed companies and in Government jobs even if not placed through campus placement drives on the recommendations of HOD concerned, HOD (T&P), Dean (Academics) and approved by Director, on case to case basis". <p>In view of the aforementioned facts and taking a lenient view for his future growth, the case was recommended by Dean (Academics) on dated 10.06.2022, to Director, SLIET, for ex-post-facto approval, for early joining in a Government job and subsequently to grant the permission to submit his thesis by 30th June, 2022.
