<ul> <li>Dean (Academics), SLIET, wrote a letter No. Dean (A) / 2022 / 392 dated 23.05.2022, to the Chairman, SET-2022, to frame a policy to attract the girls students to boost the ratio of girls students, vis-à-vis the total admitted students in the Institute.</li> <li>The proposal submitted to attract the girls students vide his letter dated 06.06.2022, is reproduced below:- <ol> <li>In addition to the existing 5% TFW, an additional TFW of 5% of the sanctioned strength exclusively for the girl students be provided, subject to fulfilling any of the following criterion; <ol> <li>Single girl child for all the programmes;</li> <li>Girls having rank of 1 to 50,000 in the JEE (Mains) examination for BE programme;</li> <li>Only two girls children in a family for ICD and BE programmes, subject to the annual income of the family being less than Rs.2.50 lacs;</li> <li>District / State level winner in any the sports activities</li> <li>So% TFW to girls siblings admitted in the Institute for ICD and BE programmes;</li> <li>Free accommodation (room rent for hostels) to all girls students belonging to EWS, OBC NCL, SC and ST categories for ICD and BE programmes, subject to the annual income of the family being less than Rs.2.50 lacs.</li> </ol> </li> <li>The proposal submitted by Chairman, SET-2022, is placed at <u>Annexure-"G"(page 37 to 38)</u>. He has conveyed that a meeting of the Board of Studies of Mathematics was held on 13.07.2021, wherein the eligibility criteria for admission to M. Sc. (Mathematics) was kept as under <i>"B. Sc. / B. A. with Mathematics as one of the subjects"</i> However, the department felt a need to revise / modify the eligibility criteria for admission to M. Sc (Mathematics). O. letter referred above, it has been conveyed that the Commission has been receiving large number of grievances from the students enrolled in different programmes of study offered b Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) regarding the delay in awarding the Degrees. Further, the relevant para on the subject is re-produced below:- <i>"The Degree award date/s shall be within 180 days of the date/s by which the students are expected to qualify and become eligible for them"</i> . In a meeting of Deans/HODs held on 14.12.2021, it was discussed and resolved that the Annua Convocation may be scheduled on the Foundation Day of the Institute, i.e. 20 <sup>th</sup> December, ever year. Further, in case the Annual Convocation could not be held on the Foundation Day of the Institute, then the condition stipulated by the UGC, as above, be allowed to be ensured. All supporting documents in this regard are placed at <u>Annexure-"J"(page 44 to 49)</u> . The matter is placed before the Senate, for deliberations and decision, please.

	In case, a student fails to submit a request to withdraw from a semester, he / she may be allowed to re-register only with the permission of Director. He / she is required to pay all the semester fee and charges of the intervening semesters along with Rs.200/- as re-registration fee and normal semester fee and charges.		
	In all such cases, the concerned student will be required to submit an affidavit/self- declaration by the parents clearly stating that he / she was not involved / indulged in any unlawful activity during his / her absence or temporary withdrawal from the Institute".
