NAVJEET KAUR GILL</p> <p>Dr. Navjeet Kaur Gill, a resident of United Arab Emirates (working in the Healthcare sector of the for the past 9 years, after working in various sectors in India for 9 years), requested SLIET, Longowal (vide email dated 12th April, 2023) that she would like to sponsor the tuition fees for one student of M. Tech in the form of a scholarship in her father's name Late. S. Rajinder Pal Singh Gill.</p> <p>Her father was an engineer from the village Duggan (next to SLIET) and served 32 years for Maharashtra State Electricity Board as Deputy Chief Engineer. He retired and shifted to Sangrur in 1996 and passed away in 1998. She was a child then but she wanted to keep his legacy in an academic way. She specifically desired/ requested that the beneficiary student should be from a poor background, who actually requires educational support.</p> <p>The following points were agreed upon by Dr. Navjeet Kaur Gill through email:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Scholarship will be offered in the name of Late S. Rajinder Pal Gill. For poor student, who actually require educational support. Family income of the beneficiary student should be less than 5 lakh per annum. In case of non-availability of candidate having family income of Rs.5 lakh per annum, the limit can be increased upto Rs.8 lakhs. In no case, the family income should exceed Rs.8 lakhs per annum. Student getting any other fellowship/ Scholarship will not be eligible. Scholarship/ Tuition fee will be granted only on the basis of merit in Entrance Examination (conducted by SLIET), while getting admission in M.Tech. Program at SLIET, Longowal. To continue the scholarship, the student shall bear good moral character and attain 6.67 CGPA at the end of every Semester. Dr. Navjeet Kaur Gill opted for Corpus fund of Rs.10,00,000/- (ten lakh only) as one-time payment and that the interest on the deposited corpus fund be reimbursed to the selected candidate/ student towards his/ her tuition fee as Scholarship/ Sponsorship. It was also agreed by her that the tuition fee be granted to the beneficiary student only on the basis of merit in the entrance examination (conducted by SLIET), while getting admission in any M.Tech. 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
