Sir,

I am directed to state that on the recommendations of the National Expert Committee, the Minister for Human Resource Development, in his capacity as Chairman, All India Council for Technical (AICTE), has approved the setting up of Longowal Institute of Engineering & Technology, Longowal, Punjab for introduction of 12 certificate courses and 10 diploma courses in the first phase of its development in the various fields as shown in Annexure-A. These courses will be designed and conducted on modular pattern and duration of the course will be 2-year at each level.

2. The Institute during its development in the second and third phases will conduct more certificate and diploma level programmes, besides degree level programmes as and when the need arises. In addition, the Institute will provide non-formal education and training to persons from unorganised sectors of population and school drop-outs to enable them to acquire basic technical skill so that they are gainfully employed. Entrepreneurship Development will be an in-built feature in the curriculum of all courses so as to motivate pass-outs to become self-employed. There will also be provision for lateral entry into diploma course after 10+2 or equivalent and degree course as and when started after B.Sc. or Polytechnic diploma or equivalent with the provision of bridge courses of specific duration. The introduction of degree courses would be subject to the approval of the report of the National Expert Committee.

3. The job opportunities shall be taken into account in designing the courses so that those who qualify at the various

levels do not have to remain without employment once they come out of the institution. Dovetailing of skills required, whether for self-employment or jobs, with education, training and skills imparted shall be duly ensured by the Institute.

4. The overall non-recurring estimates for the 1st Phase for the establishment of this Institute will be as under:-

The details of non-recurring expenditure viz. building, equipment, library, furniture and vehicles are given in Annexure-1. The cost given as above was estimated at the time of the formulation of the project. The cost shall, therefore, be subject to the escalation of the prices. The upward revision of the cost will be subject to the recommendations of the Management Committee of the Institute and the approval of the administrative Ministry of the Government of India.

5. The total cost of the Institute for running of courses in the first year would be Rs.45.00 lakhs. The ultimate recurring cost would be Rs.241.00 lakhs when the Institute become fully functional (details given in Annexure-II). The recurring expenditure includes the expenditure on teaching staff, supporting and technical staff, administrative staff and other recurring items of expenditure including consumables, maintenance, travelling and other allowances etc.

6. The Institute will be funded entirely by the Central

Government but the developed land for the Institute and electricity, water etc. will be provided by the State Government.

7. There will be an intake of 20 students in each course at all levels in the 1st Phase.

8. The courses at the two lower levels i.e. Certificate and Diploma, will be terminal and at the same time there will be continuity at both these levels. Certain percentage of students will be siphoned out either voluntarily or compulsarily. At the same time others who are keen and have the necessary capability can go up the ladder, through appropriate bridge courses, to the degree level.

9. The faculty of the proposed institute would be as follows:

i) Dean	<u>2</u>
ii) Assistant Professors	22
iii) Senior Lecturers	27
iv) Lecturers/Others	<u>145</u>
Total posts:	<u>196</u>

The full complement of posts proposed to be created may be seen at Annexure-II. The Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology, Longowal would be conducting besides the regular courses, appropriate bridge courses to enable some students to join the next level of higher courses. In addition, the Institute would have to cater to the diverse requirements of the Region for which a large number of electives would be offered in the courses at all levels, i.e. Certificate, Diploma and Degree. Introduction of non-formal technical education and entrepreneurship development will further add to the teaching load. Adding all these additional loads, the ratio would come up to the acceptable norm generally obtaining in other technical institutions of the same level in the country. However, at the time of sanction the necessary staff, the Management Committee of the Institution, Ministry of Human Resource Development and all other concerned will ensure that the effective teacher student ratio for the various courses would be as follows:

i) Certificate courses	<u>1:12</u>
ii) Diploma courses	<u>1:10</u>
iii) Degree courses	<u>1:8</u>

The full complement of staff will be recruited subject to the fulfilment of the above teacher student ratio. As such the recruitment of the faculty at any point of time will be as per the student strength. Total complement of faculty, mentioned above, would act as a ceiling. The inverse ratio of teachers shall be as

recommended by the Madan Committee on staff structure in technical institutions. So far as degree courses are concerned, the ratio of Professor, Assistant Professor, Lecturer will be 1:2:4. In respect of Diploma and Certificate courses the ratio of senior teacher and junior teacher will be 1:3. The grouping of teachers among senior and junior shall be as per general norms and recommendations of the Madan Committee.

10. The non-teaching, administrative and supporting staff shall be as given in the Project Report of the Institution. The expenditure on the non-teaching and other supporting and administrative staff shall, however, not exceed 50% of the expenditure on the teaching staff.

11. The Institution will be autonomous in character and registered as a Society under the Societies Registration Act. The Administrative and Academic matters of the Institute will be managed by a Board of Governors which has already been registered as a Society. There will also be a close association between the Institute and the other Universities/Institution in the Northern Region to co-relate the courses with the well-defined and well established needs and to avoid duplication and overlapping.

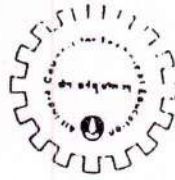

The above approval is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions :

- (1) The Infrastructural facilities including building, equipment, staff etc. should be provided as worked out by NEC for the Second Phase of the project. The estimates of non-recurring and recurring expenditure are given (Annexure-I) to this letter and the details for which are given in the Annexure-A of the Report of the MEC for the Second Phase.
- (2) The Institute will conduct the bridge courses and the non-formal and entrepreneurship programmes as approved by the NEC.
- (3) The admission to the courses should be made on merit as per the table given below :

- (4) The Institute has to comply with all the provisions of the Scheme laid down by the Supreme Court in the judgement dated 4.2.1993 as applicable in toto with the approval of the authorities concerned. The compliance with this condition is the sole responsibility of the Institute.
- (5) The Institute will not start the Degree courses without obtaining the affiliation from the concerned University.
- (6) The teaching staff should be recruited on All India basis by open selection and as per procedure, qualifications experience etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selections would be permissible for such posts for which the State Govt. prescribes "State-based Selection" as a general policy.
- (7) The tuition fee and other fees should be within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE.
- (8) The AICTE scales of pay should be granted to the teaching faculty.
- (9) The Institute should not alter the approved intake under any circumstances without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (10) The Institute should neither close any of the approved courses nor start any new course without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (11) The institute shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the Institute with the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to withdrawal of approval would be that of the Institute.

The infrastructural facilities would be reviewed by the NRC of the AICTE by June, 1994 for assessing compliance with the above stated conditions.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action in the matter and keep the Northern Regional Committee (NRC) office at Kanpur, and this Council informed of the progress made in this behalf.

Sir/ Madam,

As you are aware, All India Council for Technical Education has been mandated under the AICTE Act, 1987 to ensure maintenance of norms and standards with regard to technical education in the country. In pursuance of this mandate, the Council insists on fulfillment of the minimum requirements prescribed for imparting technical education by the institution so that quality is not compromised and stakeholders are satisfied. The Council also undertakes Annual Inspection of the institutions and conveys deficiencies to them for rectification.

It has been observed however that notwithstanding the Council's repeated advice to comply with minimum norms and standards, many institutions continue to be complacent about taking steps to remedy the deficiencies.

In case of Government/Government aided institutions/Universities departments, the Council has been specially supportive and sympathetic on account of the fact that Government institutions provide technical education at a reasonable cost besides transparent admissions. It is however a matter of regret that many such institutions suffer from critical deficiencies of faculty and other requirements. Feedback of students with regard to quality of education imparted by some institutions has evoked grave concern. The Expert Committees, following holistic appraisal during inspections, have also pointed out severe shortages in key areas evoking serious concern.

Your institution, on appraisal, has been found to be suffering from several deficiencies which are listed in Annexure-A for your perusal. Non-availability of faculty is the most serious one.

The deficiencies, particularly with reference to faculty, are of grave concern to the Council. In spite of this, it has been decided that approval in respect of your institution for the year 2005-06 as indicated below, be given with the hope that you shall take urgent steps to rectify deficiencies, particularly shortage of faculty. The Council shall monitor progress in this regard carefully and shall be constrained to put your institution in no admission/reduced intake category for the year 2006-07 in case of noncompliance. 
