
	<p>Thereafter w.e.f. 01.07.1997, the Institute was affiliated with Punjab Technical University (PTU), Jalandhar for award of Degrees. The students of B.E. upto 2006 admitted batch and students of M.Tech. 2002 to 2006 batch (M.Tech. starting year 2002) were awarded degrees under affiliation with PTU, Jalandhar. The DMCs were issued to these students by the Institute on behalf of Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar upto 2000 batch and DMCs from 2001 to 2006 batches were issued by the Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar. All Degree Certificates were issued by PTU, Jalandhar.</p>
	<p>The Institute was declared Deemed to be University from 2007.</p>
	<p>The Students enrolled during affiliation with Punjabi University and Punjab Technical University approach the Institute for issuance of number of documents e.g. Transcripts/ attestation of documents for Transcripts/ DMCs/ Duplicate DMCs/ English Medium Certificate/ Issuance of Study Scheme/ Syllabus/ Character Certificate/ Pass certificate required by Embassies/ NOC to PTU for documents issued by PTU like DMCs/ Migration Certificate/ Degree Certificate etc.</p>
	<p>At present, the Institute (SLIET) is charging nominal fees for issuance of documents from these students, as applicable/ is being charged from all other students of the Institute. However, no fees for issuing-forwarding NOC/ Letter/ attestation of documents for transcripts etc. to Punjabi University, Patiala / Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar is being charged from these ex-students.
