	proposed to introduce a Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.) programme in "Artificial			
	Intelligence and Data Science" with an intake of 60 students from AY 2025-26, at SLIET, Longowal. Annexure - G (Page 148 to 175)			
		me in "Artificial Intelligence and Data Science" aligns with the		
	Institute's mission to provide Non formal, flexible, modular, multipoint entry programmes in engineering and technology.			

For filling the seats through vertical movement from ICD (CSE) to the proposed the B.E. programme in "Artificial Intelligence and Data Science", it is also proposed that the seats of ICD in Computer Science and Engineering may be increased from existing 60 seats to 120 seats from the AY 2025-26 as per mandate of the Institute.
The existing infrastructure shall be used for the proposed programme by the Department of CSE. The proposed programme shall also require dedicated labs equipped with high-performance computing resources, software tools, equipments and data storage facilities. For establishing the laboratories, requirements shall be submitted by the Department of Computer Science and Engineering in due course of time, separately. Estimated budget for the initial setup will be prepared by the Department of CSE, covering expenses such as infrastructure development, faculty recruitment, and resource procurement. To support this programme, the recruitment of faculty with expertise in Artificial Intelligence and data science and related fields will be necessary. The Department will run the proposed programme within the sanctioned strength of faculty. The Department shall also conduct Faculty Development Programmes and continuous training to ensure
the advancements of faculty members. The detailed curriculum shall be prepared by the Department through its Board of Studies immediately after the approval from Senate. The Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.) programme in "Artificial Intelligence and Data Science" is proposed to commence from the next academic session 2025-26, subject to completion of necessary preparations. Application for starting B.E. in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science from the academic session 2025-26 shall also be submitted to AICTE through AICTE web portal.
The proposal to start B.E. in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science in the Institute from the academic session 2025-26 with an intake of 60 students is hereby submitted for kind consideration and approval by the Senate, please.
